

e-IEP PRO Quick Track Feature

The e-IEP PRO Quick Track Feature is an optional, fully integrated, goals tracking feature for schools and special education professionals to better track, report and collaborate on student progress towards mastering IEP goals (as documented in the student's e-IEP PRO IEP document), while also showing the effectiveness of their programs and services. Daily progress on all student goals can be easily and graphically logged and tracked.

Quickly Document Progress

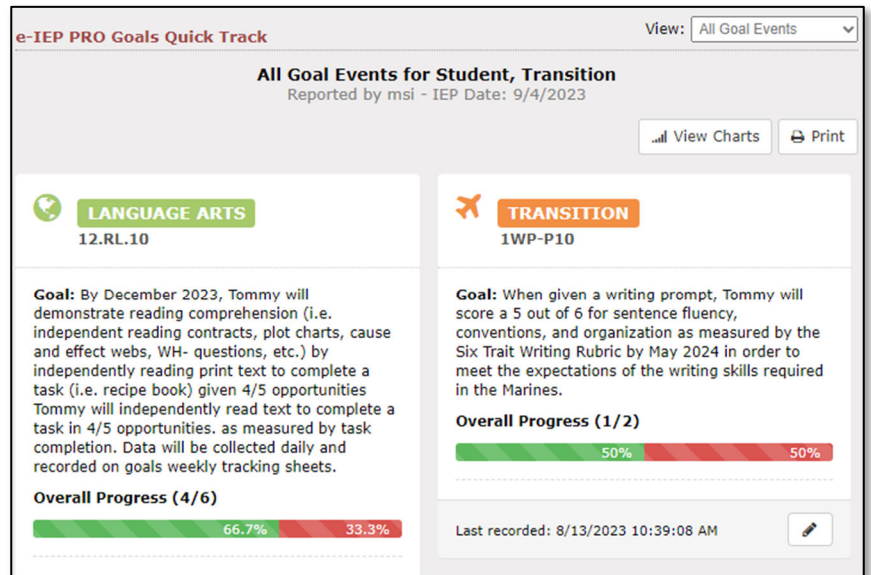
With the Quick Track feature, for each goal and for each day, special education teachers and providers can quickly document if a specific goal was successfully completed, the student's mood and add a note. The Quick Track feature is fully integrated with the e-IEP PRO interface and allows documenting progress for each goal in a student's IEP.

Quickly View Progress

As goals completion information is entered, the Overall Progress is automatically generated and visually displayed in a graphical progress bar. Summary information for each goal can be graphically viewed and printed where the individual day completion status and mood as well as the summary for completion and mood are displayed. Additionally, a set of reports for the Quick Track information is also available.
